WHY ADVENTURE ELOPEMENTS?

✦ CHOOSING THE PERFECT LOCATION ✦

Choosing your elopement location is like setting the stage for your story. This day is all about being together in a place that feels right for you - whether that's a mountain range under a big sky, a hidden beach cove, or a quiet, magical forest. Let's look at some locations that could set the perfect scene:



MOUNTAINS

If nothing feels better than that fresh mountain air and those sweeping views, consider a mountain elopement.

Imagine exchanging vows in the peaks of Glacier National Park, in the rugged Tetons, or along the Cascades' forested trails. A mountain backdrop gives you so much to explore, whether it's a sunrise hike, a lake tucked into the hills, or a cozy spot with a panoramic view.


DESERTS AND CANYONS

If wide-open spaces and dramatic colors call to you, consider a desert or canyon elopement. Joshua Tree's unique landscape, Sedona's red rocks, or the surreal canyons of Utah and Arizona can bring a different kind of wild beauty to your day.



FORESTS

For a quieter, grounded vibe, a forest setting gives you that “just us” feeling. The Redwood forests in California or the misty trails of the Smokies are perfect for an intimate ceremony surrounded by towering trees. Picture a hidden spot where the light filters softly through the leaves - beautiful, serene, and timeless.




BEACHES AND COASTS

For a mix of calm and adventure, the beach can bring all the magic. Think of Oregon’s rugged coast or the softer sands of the Outer Banks in North Carolina. Waves crashing, sandy toes, the open sky - all make for an unforgettable moment. A sunset ceremony here can feel like it’s just you two and the world.



WATERFALLS AND RIVERS

If you’re looking for something a little different, waterfalls are just as amazing. Picture yourself in front of a stunning waterfall, feeling the cool mist on your face and surrounded by greenery. Whether it’s a famous spot or a hidden gem, the vibe is magical. The sound of the water and the sunlight sparkling off it create epic photo opportunities that capture all the joy of your day.





TIPS FOR FINDING THE PERFECT SPOT



Think about what feels natural for you two. Is it the mountains, the ocean, the woods? This setting is going to play a big part in the feel of your day, so let it reflect *you*. Once you have an idea of the type of spot you want, here are some tips to help you find *the* place:

CHECK LOCAL LAWS AND PERMITS

Scenic spots, especially in state or national parks, often require permits for ceremonies. It's worth checking online or calling to make sure you're set up with the right permits and know any rules for the area. The last thing you want is a surprise on the day, and this small detail helps protect these beautiful places for others too.

SCOUT YOUR SPOT (OR GET SOME HELP)

If you can visit ahead of time, scouting your location can help you get a feel for the layout and maybe even discover a hidden gem or two. If getting there early isn't possible, hiring a photographer or guide who can help plan is a great alternative - they'll know the best spots and how to make the most of your surroundings.

Alltrails is another amazing option for researching locations too!

THINK ABOUT ACCESSIBILITY & ADVENTURE LEVEL

Your elopement doesn't have to be extreme to be amazing. If you're both up for a mountain hike, go for it! But if you'd rather take it easy, there are still plenty of spots with that adventurous vibe that don't require strenuous hiking. Think about what feels comfortable for both of you on this special day.

PLAN FOR WEATHER FLEXIBILITY


Nature can surprise us, and sometimes the weather doesn't cooperate. It's a good idea to have a couple of backup spots nearby, like a cozy area sheltered by trees or a scenic viewpoint that works in rain or shine.

WHEN AND HOW TO BOOK

Some spots are accessible all year, but others may be limited by the season. For example, mountain passes might close in winter, and coastal spots can be breezier or foggier at certain times of the year. If your dream spot is a popular one, booking in advance will help secure your date and location.

For private or secluded areas, reach out to local authorities if you're unsure about access or any regulations. And if you plan to bring a small group, make sure there's room for everyone to be comfortable.

Remember, your elopement location doesn't have to be famous or "Instagram-worthy" - it just has to feel meaningful to you both. Think of yourselves in your chosen spot, saying your vows in the open air. Think about what's going to make you feel most at ease and in love. This day is about celebrating the two of you in a way that feels authentic and free. Take your time choosing, follow what feels right, and let yourselves get excited about the adventure ahead.



WHAT TIME OF YEAR SHOULD YOU ELOPE?

The season you choose is going to set the whole mood of your elopement day. Each one brings its own vibe, from spring's fresh blooms to winter's cozy, quiet magic. Here's a look at what each season has to offer and some things to keep in mind as you plan:

SUMMER

Summer gives you long days and access to just about anywhere. Mountains, trails, and hidden spots are open, and you can plan for those sunrise-to-sunset moments. Popular areas can get busy, though, so if you're after that private feel, we can find you a lesser-known spot or go early in the morning or later in the evening to avoid the crowds. Summer's warmth and energy make it ideal for those who want a big outdoor adventure.

FALL


Fall is full of nostalgia, with cooler air and those rich, golden colors that make everything feel a little more magical. If you're dreaming of vibrant leaves and cozy vibes, autumn is the way to go. Timing can be everything, though, since peak colors are brief and vary year to year. Mid-to-late fall can get chilly, especially in the mountains, but it's hard to beat that breathtaking color.

WINTER

Winter brings this quiet, intimate feel that's hard to find any other time. Picture fresh snow, bare trees, and a soft, serene landscape that feels like your own winter wonderland. While some places might be harder to reach or even closed, the beauty of a snowy scene and that extra cozy vibe can make winter so worth it. You'll just need to layer up and plan for chilly temps and maybe some snow-friendly boots!

SPRING

Spring is all about new beginnings, with everything blooming and coming back to life. Picture soft colors, wildflowers, and that feeling of fresh energy. Temperatures are usually mild, but be ready for surprises - higher elevations might still have snow, and rain is always possible. If you're drawn to gentle, colorful landscapes, spring could be your perfect season.



WHAT ABOUT THE TIME OF DAY?

Not only does the season matter, but the time of day you choose can totally change the feel of your elopement photos and experience. Here's a quick breakdown:

SUNRISE


Imagine the world just waking up, the quiet light filtering through, and having an epic spot all to yourselves. Morning light is soft and super flattering, giving your photos that calm, peaceful vibe. It's perfect if you're early risers and want a little solitude at your dream location.

MID-DAY

Midday might be a little bright and intense in open areas, it can also create stunning images with the sunshine on your cheeks, and it also works well in spots with natural shade—think forests or canyons. If you're drawn to rugged landscapes or plan to explore all day, midday light can create some beautiful contrasts and depth, especially if you're in an adventurous setting.

SUNSET

There's a reason golden hour is such a favorite. Sunset light is warm and dreamy, adding that beautiful glow to your photos. The whole world feels like it's turning gold, and it's an amazing way to wrap up your day. Sunset can be a popular time, so if you want privacy, we can plan around it to find the best spot.



EMBRACE THE ELEMENTS!

Mother Nature has her own plans sometimes, so flexibility is key. Here are some ways to work with the weather, whatever season you pick:

SPRING RAIN

Rain is part of the season's charm, adding depth and color to your photos. Clear umbrellas or a light waterproof layer can turn a rainy day into something beautifully moody and intimate.

SUMMER STORMS

Some areas, especially mountains and coastal spots, can get quick but intense storms in the summer. They usually pass fast, but it's a good idea to have a light rain jacket and maybe a backup sheltered spot.

FALL WINDS

Fall breezes can add that wild, windswept feel to your photos, so don't worry about your hair, it always turns out beautiful - but layering up will keep you nice and cozy. High elevations can be unpredictable, so an extra blanket and scarf can help.

WINTER CHILL

Winter weddings are gorgeous, but staying warm is a must. Wool layers, a cozy jacket, and warm boots will keep you comfortable while still looking stylish. Embrace the winter look, and let it add to the magic.

CHOOSING THE PERFECT DATE

If you're looking at popular spots, consider eloping on a weekday to skip the crowds. For those specific visions - like snow-capped mountains or peak fall colors - doing a little research or chatting with an expert can make all the difference. And remember, I'm always here to help you find that perfect date and spot.

At the end of the day, your elopement is all about you two in your dream place, with nature as your backdrop. So whatever season, weather, or time you choose, it's going to be perfect because it's *your* story.





CREATING AN EXPERIENCE

Picture yourselves hiking to a stunning viewpoint, wandering along a secluded beach, or discovering a hidden waterfall. It's all about the thrill of exploring together. (you never know what we may see!)



SUNSET AND STARGAZING


Round out your day as the sun dips below the horizon, and stay out under the stars, soaking in every second together.

★ YOUR CEREMONY: ★

VOWS, TRADITIONS, AND PERSONAL TOUCHES

Your ceremony is the heartbeat of your elopement day - the moment where everything else fades away, and it's just the two of you. Whether you're standing on a mountainside, by the ocean, or in the quiet of a forest, this time is yours to speak from the heart, honor your connection, and make the experience as personal and real as you want. ★ WRITING AND ★ PERSONALIZING YOUR VOWS

With just the two of you, your vows can be as raw, real, and heartfelt as you'd like. Whether you already know exactly what you want to say or need some gentle guidance, we'll make sure your words feel authentic and unforgettable. Here's how:

FIND INSPIRATION

Look back at your love story. Maybe it's an inside joke, a shared adventure, or the little things that made you fall in love. These are the moments that will bring your vows to life and make them feel truly special.

SPEAK FROM THE HEART

Don't worry about making your vows perfect. This is a moment between you two, not a performance. Focus on what you feel, what you promise, and the dreams you look forward to sharing.

ADD A SURPRISE TOUCH

HANDBASTING OR RING WARMING



ADDING CULTURAL OR FAMILY TRADITIONS





ANCESTRAL OR SPIRITUAL ELEMENTS



If you have a song that's meaningful to you, consider playing it softly or even singing a line together. Or you can let nature be the soundtrack - the rustle of leaves, the sound of waves, or the call of birds can be perfect, either recorded or at a setting these sounds occur frequently.

ELOPEMENT TIMELINE INSPO

Your elopement day is all about crafting an experience that feels just right for the two of you - whether that means exploring from sunrise to starlight or stretching the celebration over a few days. There's no rulebook, only endless possibilities! To help you start dreaming, I've created some sample timelines that show just how magical a full-day or multi-day elopement can be. Think morning hikes to hidden views, cozy nights by the fire, and all the personal touches that make your love story unique. Dive in, get inspired, and picture what an adventure elopement could look like for you two.



SAMPLE #1

MULTI-DAY BACKPACKING ELOPEMENT ADVENTURE

DAY 1: Arrival and Backpacking with Friends & Family

1:00 PM - ARRIVAL AT TRAILHEAD

Arrive at the trailhead with close friends and family who will be part of your journey. We'll take our time to gather gear, chat with everyone, and soak in the excitement.

2:00 PM - BEGIN HIKE WITH FRIENDS & FAMILY

Start your hike up the trail, leading your loved ones halfway up the mountain. We'll pause along the way to capture group photos, laughter, and candid moments in the stunning surroundings.

5:00 PM - SET UP CAMP & ENJOY THE EVENING

Reach a beautiful spot to set up camp with your friends and family. After settling in, everyone can take a moment to relax, unwind, and appreciate the natural beauty around us.

6:00 PM - DINNER IN THE WILDERNESS

Share a cozy outdoor dinner together, either prepared over a campfire or brought along. I'll capture these moments as you all connect, share stories, and celebrate your upcoming elopement day.

7:00 PM - CAMPFIRE, MUSIC & STARGAZING

Gather around the campfire with loved ones for music, storytelling, and stargazing. Bring out a guitar, toast marshmallows, and share laughter as everyone enjoys this special night under the stars.



SAMPLE #1

MULTI-DAY BACKPACKING ELOPEMENT ADVENTURE

DAY 2: Sunrise Elopement Day

5:30 AM - SUNRISE HIKE TO CEREMONY LOCATION

Wake up early for a sunrise hike to a secluded ceremony spot. Your friends and family will help tear down camp and meet us at the trailhead later in the day. The sunrise hike will offer beautiful lighting and quiet moments as we make our way up together.

6:00 AM - GETTING READY & FIRST LOOK

Arrive at the ceremony location, taking time to get ready amidst nature's beauty. I'll capture a heartfelt first look among the breathtaking views - letting you take a moment to truly soak in some time together before the vows.

7:00 AM - PRIVATE CEREMONY

Exchange vows in a private ceremony, just the two of you, in a stunning, secluded setting. I'll quietly document this intimate celebration, allowing you to focus entirely on each other in the stillness of nature.

8:30 AM - RETURN TO TRAILHEAD TO CELEBRATE

Hike back down the trail, reuniting with friends and family at the trailhead. Together, we'll celebrate with toasts, hugs, and photos to capture this joyful moment. Bring along light snacks or mimosas for a small post-ceremony toast!

11:00 AM - ADVENTURE ACTIVITIES

Spend the afternoon with your loved ones by the lake, choosing from activities like canoeing, kayaking, or a group horseback ride. These activities give everyone a chance to bond, explore, and make memories while I document everyone's laughter and shared adventure.

2:00 PM - PORTRAIT SESSION WITH COUPLE & FAMILY

Capture more moments with your partner and family as we explore scenic spots for photos. These portraits will tell the story of your adventure-filled day and the joy of being surrounded by loved ones.

4:00 PM - DINNER CELEBRATION WITH FAMILY & FRIENDS

End the day with a special dinner in a cozy setting - whether at your camp, a lodge, or a rustic outdoor dining space. Share toasts, laughter, and delicious food as the perfect close to your elopement celebration.





SAMPLE #2



FULL-DAY ALASKAN ELOPEMENT ADVENTURE

MORNING: Getting Ready

8:00 AM - COFFEE & QUIET TIME

Wake up in your cozy cabin or Airbnb, taking in the Alaskan wilderness around you. Enjoy a quiet breakfast together and take in the peace of the day ahead.

9:00 AM - GETTING READY SEPARATELY

Spend the morning getting ready in separate areas of the cabin. Take your time with the full prep: hair, makeup, and details that make you feel your absolute best. Meanwhile, I'll capture the candid moments and all the excitement and anticipation.

11:00 AM - FIRST LOOK OUTSIDE YOUR AIRBNB OR CABIN

Step outside for a breathtaking first look surrounded by Alaska's wild beauty. This is your moment to take each other in, fully present, as the day truly begins.

EARLY AFTERNOON: Legal Ceremony & Helicopter Adventure

12:00 PM - QUICK LEGAL CEREMONY AT A LOCAL LODGE

We'll meet your officiant at a rustic Alaskan lodge to sign your marriage certificate and make things official. This quick ceremony keeps things simple but meaningful.

1:00 PM - HELICOPTER RIDE TO GLACIAL FIELDS & ICEBERGS

Hop into a helicopter for an incredible ride over icebergs, glacial fields, or the Kenai Fjords. The scenery below is otherworldly, giving you both a sense of awe as we're whisked away to the remote spot where you'll say your vows.

1:30 PM - VOW EXCHANGE

Touch down in a remote area and take in the untouched beauty around you. Here, in the stillness of Alaska's wild, exchange your vows—just the two of you. With the icy, blue landscapes all around, this is a moment that I'll document in all its intimate, raw, and unforgettable glory.

2:00 PM - EXPLORING & PORTRAITS

Spend time exploring this surreal landscape together, and I'll capture it all. Laugh, wander, and take it all in as newlyweds, with the glacial fields and crisp Alaskan air adding to your adventure.

3:30 PM - RETURN HELICOPTER RIDE TO THE LODGE

We'll hop back in the helicopter and enjoy the scenic journey back to the lodge, where you can savor the thrill of the day's adventure.

EVENING: Dinner & Celebration

5:00 PM - DINNER AT THE LODGE

Arrive back at the lodge for a celebratory dinner. Enjoy a cozy, delicious meal together, reflecting on the day's moments and everything that made it special.

6:30 PM - RETURN TO YOUR CABIN OR AIRBNB

Head back to your cabin for some quiet, intimate time together. Change into comfortable clothes and relax as the sun starts to set.

7:30 PM - FIRST DANCE BY THE CAMPFIRE

As the Alaskan blue hour descends, light a campfire near your cabin and share your first dance under the open sky. With the flickering firelight and the stars beginning to appear, this moment is yours to savor. Toast marshmallows, share stories, and soak up every moment of this unforgettable day.

8 HOUR SEDONA ELOPEMENT ADVENTURE

3:30 PM - SCENIC DRIVE TO CATHEDRAL ROCK

We'll take a relaxed drive to Cathedral Rock, one of Sedona's most breathtaking spots. With views opening up all around, this part of the day is all about being fully present and enjoying the journey together.

4:00 PM - CEREMONY AT CATHEDRAL ROCK

At a secluded spot overlooking the valley, exchange vows as the golden light of late afternoon warms the landscape.

4:45 PM - SUNSET PORTRAITS AND EXPLORATION



KEY AREAS OF YOUR ELOPEMENT BUDGET

Each elopement is unique, and where you prioritize your budget will reflect what's most meaningful to you. Here's a look at some key elopement expenses and what they typically include:

TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION (25-35%)

Getting to your ideal destination may involve flights, car rentals, and accommodations. If you're planning a remote or off-grid location, you might also need transportation services like ferry rides, train tickets, or guided off-road vehicles. Choose accommodations that allow you to relax, explore, and soak in your surroundings - this is, after all, your time to connect and celebrate without distractions.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEOGRAPHY (35-45%)

Capturing your day in a way that keeps the memories alive is a priceless investment. CEREMONY & PERMITS (5-10%)






